- Apply for scholarships.**
 - Edit your scholarship essay(s). Ask a teacher or adult to help proof your final version.
 - Apply to as many scholarships as you can!
- Visit Campus.**
 - Many colleges hold special preview days for admitted students; make an effort to attend and get to know the campus and the people!
- File taxes.**
 - Filing your FAFSA was the first step in accessing federal and state financial aid. Now you and your parents need to file taxes so you can accurately update your Student Aid Report (SAR), which colleges will use to prepare your financial aid award.
- Learn more about Jump Start.**
 - If you haven't already, talk to an Access Advisor about the Jump Start program and all of the opportunities that it offers. Find out if you are eligible and get signed up!
