Senior Year Checklist: March

- Confirm FAFSA information.
 - The Student Aid Report is a summary of what you filled out on the FAFSA – make sure that all of the information is correct and make any changes (like updating tax information once you’ve filed taxes) by March 15.
 - Note: You and your parents should file taxes as early as possible this year – before the April 15 deadline is best.
- Keep applying for scholarships.
 - The more scholarships you apply for, the more money you might have access to for college. Keep it up!
- Confirm summer plans.
 - Continue applying for a summer camp or program at a university, or an internship or job in a field you’re interested in.
 - Remember that many college orientations happen during the summer so make sure you include that in your plans!
- Keep up grades & continue participating in extracurriculars.
 - Colleges (and scholarships) look at second semester grades – so no slacking!
 - Take dual credit classes to get caught up or get ahead!
